Recommendation:

Request you to amend the High Price/ Low Price Certificate clause in the upcoming tenders. There are major issues with this clause such as:

- 1. As mentioned we cannot quote a lower price during the validity of the R.C. which usually is over 2 years. This means for 2 years all our competition will know that we will not be able to quote a price lower than BMASICL (THE RATE FOR WHICH WILL BE KNOWN TO EVERYONE). BY DOING SO, OUR RATE WILL BE OPEN TO ALL THUS NOT Allowing us to participate in any new tender during our R.C. with BMSICL.
- 2. It also a well known fact that the Raw material/API fluctuation in the industry can be more than 150% 300% within 6 months time which is in no ones control. By limiting us to quote a similar price for two years is not feasible.

It would be ideal if you can limit the High Price/Low Price Certification to the State of Bihar. That we cannot supply at a lower price during the R.C. in state of Bihar.

- 3. Also, every states consumption pattern is different. For Ex. BMSICL might tender a certain product mentioning a Qty. of 1,00,000 whereas UPMSICL or MPPMSCL may tender the same product mentioning a Qty. of 4,00,000 which usually happens.
