

MINUTES OF FINANCIAL COMMITTEE MEETING FOR OPENING OF FINANCIAL BIDS OF RE-TENDER BMSIC/DRUGS/18-02 (REGARDING RATE CONTRACT AND SUPPLY OF RAPID PLASMA REAGIN KITS & WHOLE BLOOD FINGER PRICK TEST FOR HIV KITS FOR DIFFERENT HEALTHCARE FACILITIES OF STATE OF BIHAR).

The financial committee meeting for opening of financial bids of Re- Tender No. BMSIC/DRUGS/18-02 was held on 12th November 2018 under the chairmanship of Managing Director, BMSICL. The other committee members present in the meeting were:

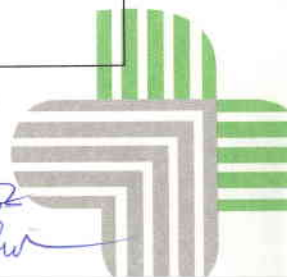



After evaluation of financial bids of the multiple bidders for Whole Blood Finger prick test for HIV Kits, it was decided to issue LoI (Letter of Intent) to the L1 bidder so declared as above.




