

**MINUTES OF TECHNICAL EVALUATION COMMITTEE MEETING OF TENDER
BMSIC/DRUGS/19-01 (RATE CONTRACT AND SUPPLY OF DRUGS FOR DIFFERENT
HEALTHCARE FACILITIES OF STATE OF BIHAR).**

Date: 10th June 2019

The **Technical Evaluation Committee Meeting of Tender No. BMSIC/DRUGS/19-01** was held on 10th June 2019 under the Chairmanship of Dr. R. D. Ranjan, Director in Chief, Department of Health, GoB. The other committee members present in the meeting were:

2. The Details of the invited tender are as follows:

1. Tender Reference No. BMSIC/DRUGS/19-01.
2. Tender floated date- 10/01/2019.
3. Last date of submission of online bids- 03/04/2019.
4. Tender Opening date- 08/04/2019.

3. Tender has been floated for 8 (Eight) drugs. It was found in the online opening that total 5 (Five) following bidders have participated in the tender.

1. Ang Life Sciences India Ltd
2. Alpa Laboratories Ltd
3. Bharat Serums and Vaccines Ltd.
4. Plasmagen Biosciences Pvt. Ltd
5. Unicure India Ltd.

4. The summary of bid received status is as follows:

1. No Bid received for 2 Drugs i.e., NIT Sl no. 4 & 5.
2. Single Bid received for 3 Drugs i.e., NIT Sl no. 1, 3 & 6.
3. Multiple Bids received for 3 Drugs i.e., NIT Sl no. 2, 7 & 8.

5. It was unanimously decided in tender opening meeting dated 08.04.2019 to proceed further for technical evaluation for 3 Drugs (NIT S. No. 2, 7 & 8) for which multiple bids have been received and re-tender for the remaining 5 Drugs for which single bid (NIT S. No. 1, 3 & 6) and zero bid (NIT S. No. 4 & 5) was received.

6. The Preliminary Evaluation of technical bids of the above-mentioned bidding firms was done by the team of Drug Inspectors deputed at BMSICL. Evaluation sheets were published on the website of BMSICL and Claims/objections were invited vide notice no.880 dated 21.05.2019.



7. After comparison of the clarification received from the bidders in the light of that notice and close examination of the documents submitted by the bidding firms, the drug wise technical evaluation findings have been recorded as follows:

8. M/s Bharat Serums and Vaccines Ltd. & M/s Plasmagen Biosciences Pvt. Ltd are importer firms for the quoted product Rabies Immunoglobulin (Human) Injection 150 IU/ml 2 ml Vial/PFS (NIT SI no.7). The manufacturing units of the other two bidders i.e. M/s Alpa Laboratories Ltd & M/s Ang Lifesciences India Ltd have been inspected earlier and BMSICL is having valid rate contract with both the firms. It was therefore unanimously decided to recommend for opening of the financial bids of the above mentioned technically qualified firms for the above-mentioned drugs.
