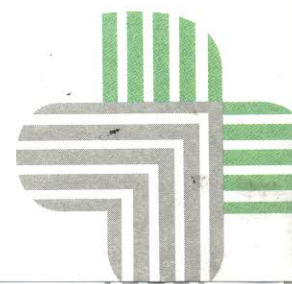


**Minutes of the meeting of Technical Evaluation Committee for Equipment Tender No. BMSICL/2017-18/ME-081, held on 01<sup>st</sup> June 2018 at Conference hall of BMSICL.**

1. Attendance:- As per the attendance register.
2. In the online opening of technical bids for tender no. BMSICL/2017-18/ME-081, It was found that two firms namely (1) M/s Vikrant Life Sciences (P) Ltd. (2) M/s Kores (INDIA) Ltd. submitted their bids for Indelible Ink Marker Pen online as well as submitted two separate sealed envelopes of samples of their respective firms in terms of specification alongwith original bids.
3. The samples were handed over to the State Health Society for testing vide letter no. 5089 dated 26.03.2018. Accordingly a Committee was formed by the SHS. The committee comprising of two members namely (i) Dr. Nihar Ranjan Ray OSA, WHO-Bihar (ii) Dr. Narendra Kumar Sinha AD(I)-cum-SIO submitted its report vide letter no. 1284 dated 28.05.2018.
4. As per the report, four slums were randomly selected for Marker pen testing on -05 year children mark in the left little finger on 15.05.2018.
5. Polio transit team tally sheet was used to tally mark the no. of children marked with the given marker pen, which was counted and recorded. Follow up was done after 7 days on 22.05.2018 for ascertaining percentage of children retaining the marking. The nail marking was checked with children of the same area where nail marking was done on 15.05.2018. The findings were recorded as given in the table below:-

6. **Result of Observation:-**


(A) Average number of children nail marked by the tested indelible Ink Marker Pen samples provided by BMSICL was found as follows:-

- Kores India Pvt. Ltd. - 484
- Vikrant Lifesciences (P) Ltd -285


(B) Percentage of children retained nail marking which was checked after 7 days found as follows:-

- Kores India Pvt. Ltd. – 87.1%
- Vikrant Lifesciences (P) Ltd- 79.2%


On the basis of above sampling assessment report, it was found that both the firms have failed in sample assessment in terms of minimum test per marker Pen which was required to be minimum 500 to 600 as per specification. It was, therefore, unanimously decided to recommend for re-tender of Indelible Ink Marker Pen.
