**CORRIGENDUM - I****e-tender(NIT) Reference No: BMSIC/20045/02-2023/01**

1. With reference to the **Notice Inviting Tender (NIT) Reference No.: - BMSIC/20045/02-2023/01** for Empanelment of Agencies for Outsourcing Different Job Profiles for Health Department Entities, published in leading newspapers and uploaded on the website “<http://www.eproc2.bihar.gov.in>”, the Pre-Bid meeting was held at 1:00 PM on 17/08/2023 at the Patna office of ‘Bihar Medical Services & Infrastructure Corporation Limited (BMSICL)’.
2. After due consideration of the queries/request raised during the pre-bid meeting/submitted via e-mail by the bidders, the amendments/clarifications recommended by the technical committee are summarized as follows:
